



## Cashless Meal System

Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2014

Dear Parent/Carer

The cashless catering system being introduced by our school's meals provider begins on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July. Nourish will not be accepting payment for food in cash either at the canteen, tuck shop or in the Sixth Form Centre. Biometrics has been taken from those who have returned the parental permission slip and students who have not done this will be issued with a pin to use instead at the tills.

To purchase food your son/daughter account needs to be in credit. Money can be added to their account either using ParentPay or students can insert cash into the reval machines outside the canteen and Sixth Form Centre. These machines can also be used by students to check their credit balances. Students on free school meals will have their accounts credited with the daily allowance. This allowance cannot be spent until 11 am and therefore not at breakfast. Accounts can be credited with additional sums of money either via ParentPay or by using cash at the reval machines.

Crediting students accounts using ParentPay is the most efficient way of using the cashless system. It avoids the need for students to bring cash and visit the reval machines before going to the canteen and it also allows parents to monitor the food students are purchasing.
