Dear Parent/Carer,

**Re: Educational Study Visit to France 27<sup>th</sup> June 2016 – 1st July 2016**

This year we would like to take students studying French in Years 8 and 9 to France during the summer Creativity Week. The visit will take place from Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016. Students will be able to practise the French language skills that they have learnt so far in various situations. We hope to include a visit to the Eiffel Tower, the Catacombes, Disney Land Paris, the Somme battle fields, and Nausicaa aquarium. Students will stay in the Chateau de Warsy on a full board basis.

The visit will be limited to 30 places. If the visit is oversubscribed, there will be a draw. Priority will be given to students studying French in Year 9 and who were on last year's waiting list. Those students who are unlucky will be placed on a waiting list for next year's visit and will have priority the following year providing they continue to study Spanish.

Students will travel on their own passport and teachers will look after all passports and EU medical cards during the visit.

The total cost of **£580.00** has been competitively sourced from the reputable travel company Globebrow Ltd, and is based on 30 places. The price includes as follows:

- Transfers to and from England and France
- Full board accommodation in the Chateau
- All organised activities
- Insurance

The following payment schedule has been arranged with our Finance Office:

- £200.00 Deposit as soon as possible (no later than Friday, 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2015)
- £100.00 2<sup>nd</sup> Instalment by Friday, 6<sup>th</sup> November 2015
- £100.00 3<sup>rd</sup> Instalment by Friday, 4<sup>th</sup> December 2015
- £100.00 4<sup>th</sup> Instalment by Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> February 2016
- £80.00 5<sup>th</sup> Instalment by Friday, 4<sup>th</sup> March 2016

All payments must be received by Friday, 4<sup>th</sup> March 2016.

If you wish your child to participate, can you please make arrangements to pay the **non-refundable £200.00 deposit** by debit/credit card on the Parentpay website at [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com). You will also need to give consent by filling the medical form attached and provide details of any medical conditions and also an emergency contact number. The medical form must be returned before Friday the 9<sup>th</sup> of October to Suzanne Harrison in the finance office. **The deposit must be received no later than Friday the 23<sup>rd</sup> of October 2015.**

Therefore could you please arrange to pay as soon as possible ensuring this is through Parentpay and that all requested information attached is provided. Please note that once your child has been accepted on the visit, **the deposit will not be refundable should he/she decides to withdraw unless the trip has to be cancelled by Campion School.**
